They beat Loyall 26-0, Jenkins 32-6, Prestonsburg 47-19, Harlan 13-12, Lynch 19-6, Bell High 34-7, Benham 19-7, Cumberland 12-7, Pineville 46-13 and Hall 21-6. The 1948 season stood as the only undefeated, untied regular season in the history of EHS for a great number of years. The wildcats won the Cumberland Valley Conference, had two men on the All-Conference team and one on the All State team. Somerset beat them in the post season.
